Voluntary Retirement Incentive Program

University

Creates flexibility for the university to align resources with new strategic vision goals related to teaching, research, and engagement

Faculty

Benefits faculty eligible for retirement



UT Board of Trustees approved the program on October 22, 2021

Faculty Eligible for the Program

- Employees who hold a regular faculty appointment (including faculty serving in administrative roles)
- Faculty who meet the following eligibility criteria as of June 30, 2022:
 - Eligible for either Service Retirement or Early Retirement under the Tennessee Consolidated Retirement System (TCRS) or the Joint Contributory Retirement System (JCRS) or other federal retirement program (FERS/CSRS) with at least 20 years of service; or
 - A participant in the Optional Retirement Program (ORP) with at least 20 years of service



Retirements Currently in Process

This Program is open to faculty who have provided written notice to administration of the intent to retire, so long as the employee has not yet separated from University service at the time of his/her/their application for participation in this Program.




Graduated Incentive Payments

20-25 years of eligible service: 6 months of base salary

26-29 years of eligible service: 9 months of base salary

30+ years of eligible service: 12 months of base salary





Separation Date

Participants will retire under this Program with a separation date no later than June 30, 2022, unless otherwise approved in writing by the University.



Continued Teaching

While post-retirement agreements are not part of the Program, colleges and units may hire retiring faculty as adjuncts on an as-needed, semester-by-semester basis.



Additional Information

- UTK may limit the number of participants in this Program and may deny participation of any applicant based on business continuity and campus needs.
- Approved participants may also be required to adjust effective date of retirement based on campus needs.



Application Process (Continued)

Eligible employees interested in participating must complete the 2022 UTK Faculty Voluntary **Retirement Incentive Program** Application and return it by December 15, 2021 to UTK Human Resources, located at 105 Student Services Building, or by e-mail attachment at vrip@utk.edu.





Acceptance in the Program

Eligible faculty applications will be reviewed as they are received and considered on a case-by-case basis.

Applicants who are accepted for participation in the Program will receive a personalized Retirement Incentive Agreement and Release document that includes the amount of the incentive payment. The notification of acceptance and the Agreement will be sent by e-mail and regular U.S. mail by **January 15, 2022**.



Final Step

The 2022 UTK Faculty Retirement Incentive Agreement and Release document should be signed and returned to Human Resources,105 Student Services Building, or by email to <u>vrip@utk.edu</u> no later than **March 1, 2022**.
